## **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

1. The Knights of Columbus #2801 will award scholarships to the applicants judged to be the most worthy by a group of worthy Knights of #2801. The decision by the group of worthy Knights of #2801 will be final.
2. Applicants must submit the following data for consideration:
  1. Completed and signed application; and,
  2. An essay explaining “Why I am Proud Of my Religion and how I show it in everyday life.” This essay must be typed and may not exceed 500 words. The recipients should include the extent and quality of their volunteer community involvement with the essay.
3. An applicant must be the legal dependent of an active, retired, or deceased brother of K of C #2801. The brother must have dues paid up to December 31 of the previous year the child is applying for the scholarship.
4. Recipients must be a graduating high school senior of the same year the application is turned in.
5. Recipients must be working toward a degree or completion of a recognized course of study and be in good scholastic standing.
6. Scholarships will be awarded in amounts approved by the Officers of the Knights of Columbus #2801.
7. Payment of the scholarship will be made by check, issued to the recipient.
8. Applications and essays must be received or postmarked no later than April 30. No other items will be considered other than the application and essay.
